At times there may be communication of a pastoral nature within the boundaries of our child protection guidelines. CFC Youth leaders and volunteers will also be signing a contract which ensures their own social networking sites and pages of personal information are of an appropriate nature.

Having relationships with young people and being in close communication with them is an essential part of CFCs approach to youth work. Telephone calls, texting, email and face to face conversations are still acceptable (and encouraged) ways for young people to communicate with leaders and build relationships.
