

Connect Bible Study - Together Week 2

As a community for our next few weeks, we are thinking about life together.

As we think about what it means to have a biblical concept of the importance of together, let's read John 2:1-5 and John 19:25-26 as a starting point.

Before you read it, take some time to settle your heart, and still your mind. Invite the Holy Spirit to speak to you, to perhaps highlight a line or a word as you read. When a line or word stands out to you, you may want to write it down.

When you are ready, read the passages together aloud. Read them slowly and as you read, think about these questions for discussion afterwards.

1. What stands out to you in these passages? Why do you think that stands out to you?
2. Is there anything that confuses you or bothers you about this passage? Can anyone else in the group shed some light on it?
3. Mary and Jesus/John are from different generations. What do these passages tell us about the power or importance of inter-generational connection?
4. Where else do you see intergenerational connection in the Bible? What does it teach us?
5. Do you think intergenerational connection is important to discipleship? Why / why not?
6. What barriers are there to forming/sustaining intergenerational connections, especially in a church context?
7. How might we best respond to this in our daily lives?

Take some time to pray for one another.
