Questions

- How do you think this happens and what does this look like for us today?
- How can we embrace the "journey" Jesus is guiding us on, as opposed to being disappointed with where we are?
- What are rhythms or practices that can help us "see" Jesus for who He is, and not allow our vision to become distorted?
